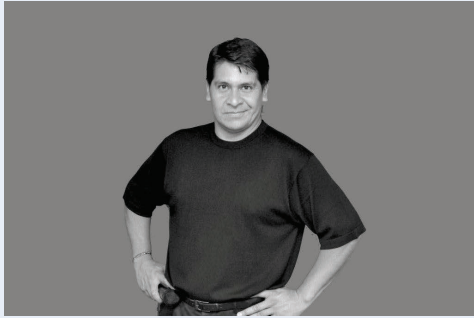

Team Building and Working Together as a Unit

Mitch will give ideas and tools to build a fun and positive foundation at work. The goal is to have staff focus together on the fun, positive foundation instead of all the negative issues at work. The staff will learn to problem solve and prevent negativity within the work area while identifying the benefits of working together to reduce stress.

Solid Leadership Through Healthy Communication
